

Body Biography

For this lesson you will be creating a written and visual portrait of a character from the story that you are reading. Use this sheet to take notes before you create your project.

You will be responsible for choosing a character and then analyzing that character using the following guidelines:

- **Heart**

- Special Relationships – Who/What is closest to this character? Place this character in the heart.
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- **Spine**

- Important goal – What is this character trying to accomplish throughout the story? What drives his/her thoughts and actions?
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- **Strengths & Weaknesses**

- What is something that you admire about your character? What is a personal quality that needs to be improved? How can that character improve this weakness?
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- **Symbols**

- What objects could be used to symbolize, or represent, the character? Why did you choose these objects?
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- **Changes**

- Use thought balloons to show how the character changed throughout the story.
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- **Mirror, Mirror**

- How does the character see himself? Display this inside a mirror.
 - How is this different from the way others see the character? Display this outside of the mirror.
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- **Name Poem**

- Create an acrostic poem using the character's name.
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- **Quote**

- Think of **appropriate** quotes that best describe the character and their growth throughout the story.
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Once you have analyzed the character using the above list, you will create a poster for your character. All of the elements included in your analysis must be included on your poster. You will be graded on completion and CREATVITY! Use your imagination and your brain power to bring the character to life!
